The attached leaflet gives transport details. There is parking at the top of Canons Drive and at the Whitchurch Lane entrance (check with signage for free parking hours), and in Donnefield Avenue. There is also parking at the Canons Park station car park but for the day rate only, which is expensive!

We will follow the usual route around the northern end of the park that we use for our Open City tours, with some history and background to the creation of the park along the way. I will point out some of our specimen trees, both old and new and if the walled garden is open by then, after pond repairs, we will visit that too.

We will then visit the southern end of the park, taking in the adventure playground and the open space, leading to the Spinney, for a quick look along there, after which we will return to the cafe for complimentary refreshments.

Depending on the numbers attending we will try to use the cafe's 'dome' tent or, for a larger attendance, one or our gazebos, if we need shelter.

Hopefully the weather will be OK so we can use the picnic tables at the café where there is a toilet.

We anticipate that the tour would take around one and a half to two hours including refreshments.
