Awareness of Health and Safety

This short course is all about keeping you safe and well. Everyone has a role in making workplaces a safe place to be, so this course introduces you to the main areas everyone should consider, no matter what environment they work in.

Equality, Diversity, and Inclusion

This short course covers different types of discrimination and unconscious biases in the workplace.
